SPECIAL EXCAVATION PERMIT

The Contractor is responsible for all safety precautions and to replace backfill and disturbed roadway pavement with temporary bituminous concrete pavement to a minimum compacted thickness of 2 inches, and to maintain the patch in proper condition until such time as the City installs the permanent pavement. All work and materials used shall be in accordance with East Providence Standards and Specifications and in accordance with the general conditions on the reverse side.

Deposit of \$ _____ (*\$30.00 per SY for Residential Roads and \$60.00 per SY for Commercial Roads*) is the estimated charge for the City of East Providence to install permanent pavement. Final charge to the Contractor shall be based on actual square yards of permanent pavement installed by the City due to the excavation. The minimum charge shall be \$300.00 for residential roads and \$600.00 for commercial roads. At the Director's discretion, the deposit may be waived and the Contractor shall be responsible for installing the permanent pavement. See reverse for additional conditions.

It is the responsibility of the Contractor to notify the Engineering Division at least **48 hours** prior to the start of excavation. This permit does not remove the Contractor's responsibility to notify other City Departments for any required permits or inspections.

The Contractor shall be responsible for contacting **DIGSAFE (1-888-344-7233)** prior to start of excavating. The Contractor shall forward the DIGSAFE number to the City.

Accompanying this application shall be a plan, showing all proposed work. The plan shall show specific locations and dimensions of the excavation.

General Conditions

During the progress of work all structures under, and above the ground, shall be properly protected from damage or injury. It shall be the duty of the Contractor to make certain that the security of the traveling public is safeguarded and its rights are not unreasonably curtailed. No detours may be engaged on any project without obtaining special permission from the Department and local authorities. The work area shall be protected at all times to avoid the possibility of accident. Said work area shall be marked with signage in accordance with the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices and The R.I. Department of Transportation. Uniformed Police Officers shall be engaged on all project where the Engineer or Police Department so orders.

The work performed under permit shall be planned and carried out so that the drainage system of the highway is effective at all times.

If the contractor performs any work contrary to the terms of this permit and after due notice, fail to rectify same, the Department may, with or without further notice correct or complete such work with its own forces and the Contractor shall reimburse the City for any expenses incurred in performing said work.

This permit may be modified or revoked at any time for cause by the Department without rendering the Department, City of East Providence or its agents liable in any way.

The Department reserves the right to order the change of location or removal of any structure or structures authorized by this permit and any conditions stated herein at any time, said change or removal to be made by and at the expense of the owner or its/their successors or assigns.

The Contractor shall be responsible for all damages to persons or property due to or resulting from any work done under the permit.

On completion of the work herein contemplated the City Right-of-Way and roadway must be in as good condition as or better than before work commenced and shall meet with the satisfaction of the Department.

CONDITIONS RELATED TO THE CONTRACTOR RESPONSIBLE FOR MAINTAINING TEMPORARY PAVEMENT AND INSTALLING PERMANENT PAVEMENT

- 1 The Contractor shall be responsible for maintaining a temporary pavement patch until placement of permanent asphalt pavement.
- 2 Permanent asphalt pavement shall be installed after a minimum of 90 days per City of East Providence Specifications and guaranteed for a 12-month period.
- 3 All work shall be in accordance with City Specifications and Standards and any attachments provided herein.
